



## **COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN MOSS GS STUDENTS**

This document lists out the preparedness plan according to the Good Shepherd Church COVID-19 Safety Protocol Policy to ensure our GS Students environments are providing a safe and impactful experience for those attending our in-person gatherings. ### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Check-In/Drop-Off will be open 15 minutes before the gathering starts until 15 minutes after the gathering ends.
  - 5:00 PM Gathering (4:45-7:15)
- All students need to be picked-up within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the gathering.
- Middle School students will be socially-distanced in the Worship Center.
- High School students will be socially-distanced in the Living Room and in their LifeGroup rooms.
- Each LifeGroup room will be limited to 50% occupancy.
- All staff, volunteers, and students will be required to wear a mask. Masks will be provided if your child or the volunteer does not have one.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at all check in stations and lifegroup rooms and areas.
- Temperatures will be checked for all staff, volunteers, and students entering the GS Students environment. Only those with temperatures below 99.5 degrees Fahrenheit will be allowed to enter the GS Students environment. If a volunteer has a temperature above 99.5 degrees Fahrenheit, they will be invited to stream and access our gathering online at [www.youtube.com/gsstudents](http://www.youtube.com/gsstudents).

### **CHECK-IN**

- Middle School–
  - We will have a check-in table for MS Students outside the Worship Lobby entrance. MS Students will enter via the worship lobby doors and move into the Worship Center. They will exit using the same doors as the ones they entered. Leaders will be holding doors open from 4:50-5:15, and 6:50-7:15.
- High School–
  - We will have a check-in table for HS Students outside the living room entrance. Students will enter via the Living Room and exit via the same doors. Doors will be propped open from 4:50-5:15, and 6:50-7:15.
- After temperature checks are completed, students will proceed to their designated area. You will notice colored "DOTS" outside to encourage social distancing while students are waiting to enter their areas.
- Please note, there is limited capacity.

### **SIGNAGE/FLOOR DOTS**

- Each lifegroup room will have a safety reminder for the room capacity.

- Colored floor dots will be placed outside by the Check-In areas. There will also be colored dots in the Worship Center for MS lifegroups.

## **VOLUNTEERS**

- Volunteers are required to wear a mask.
- All volunteers will be temperature checked and only permitted to serve if their temperature is below 99.5 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Gloves must be used when passing out supplies.

## **SECURITY**

- GS Students will continue to follow our regular guidelines according to our GS Safe Sanctuary Policy for security to ensure all students entering the GS Students environment are safe.
