Conversation Questions

1. Why do you think the term “gaslighting” has grown more common in recent years? What did you learn from the origin story of that term?
2. The marriage of David & Michal occurred “between” last week’s message and this week’s. Why do you think David agreed to marry the daughter of the man who’d tried to kill him?
3. The message suggested that people in your life will make you feel responsible for their irresponsibility. Recall a time when that happened to you. How did you respond?
4. Is there anyone in your life who insists you give up what you KNOW in exchange for getting what you WANT? How will this message alter your approach to that relationship and those demands?
5. Self-assessment: do you put people in your life to a loyalty test? Do you alter reality in order to control behavior? Be honest.
6. Think of ways Satan has our entire culture gaslit. Discuss with your group.
7. Who will you invite to the final week of Walking On Eggshells?
